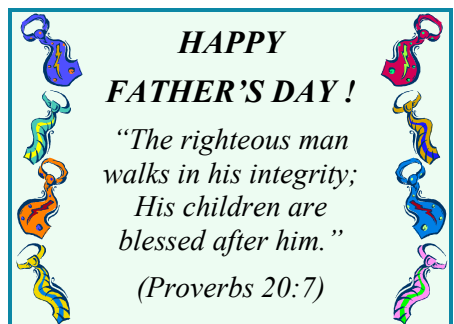
TRIBUTE TO MARIE FOSTER
